Kitchen Construction Progressing

Pius X's vision of an on-site kitchen is coming to fruition with the help of a \$500,000 grant award received from the Kohl's Cares nationwide voting contest!

As Pius X continues to grow and thrive, the new kitchen facility is a greatly-needed enhancement to our campus. The kitchen project will be completed and operational in August 2011.

In addition to the preparation of nutritional meals for students, faculty, staff, and friends, the kitchen will be a significant revenue source through enhanced concession services at athletic and school activities and facility rental for meetings, conferences, local events, and special occasion receptions. Each year, Pius X High School hosts numerous outside events including the Midwest Invitational Tournament, sponsored by the YMCA, which brings in basketball teams from all around the region to compete. Pius X also hosts the Diocesan Teacher's Institute and other diocesan meetings annually. The new facility will also assist in providing food service at the newly constructed St. Michael's School.

Currently, we are asking for assistance in funding a portion of the \$184,000 needed for new kitchen equipment. Unfunded kitchen items will be purchased through a loan at a specific interest rate.
